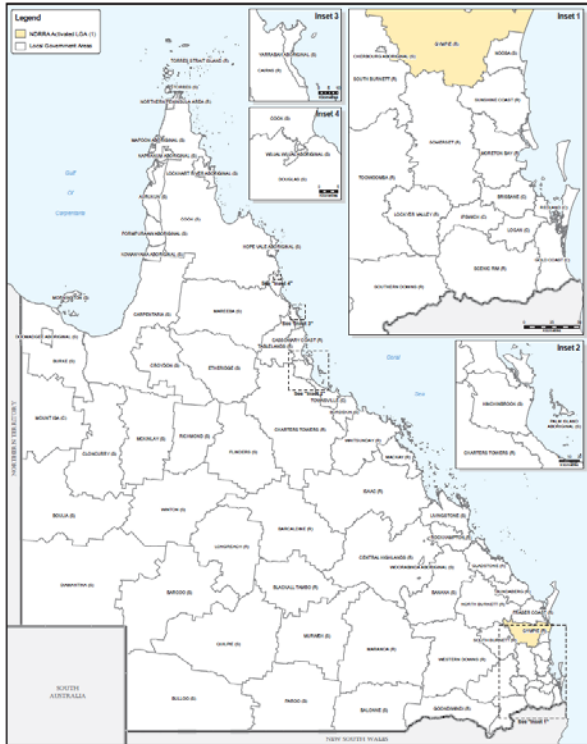




Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements event Gympie Bushfires, 19-27 September 2018



The Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA) is a jointly funded program between the Australian Government and state and territory (state) governments, through which the Australian Government provides financial assistance to support state governments with disaster recovery costs.

In response to the bushfires, assistance has been activated for the area formally defined as: *“Communities within Gympie affected by bushfires, 19-27 September 2018”*.

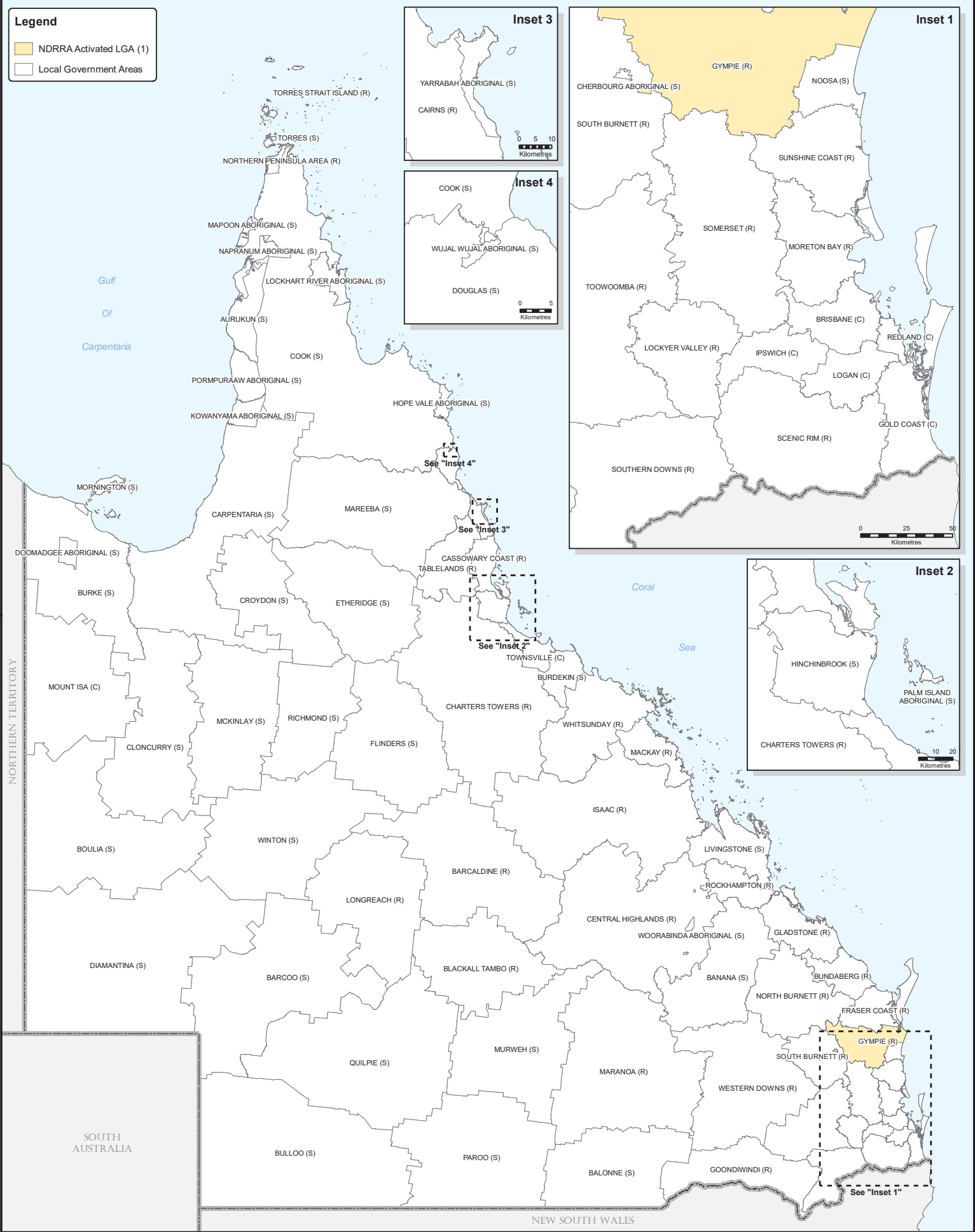

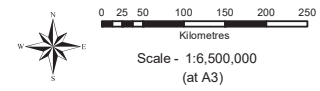
