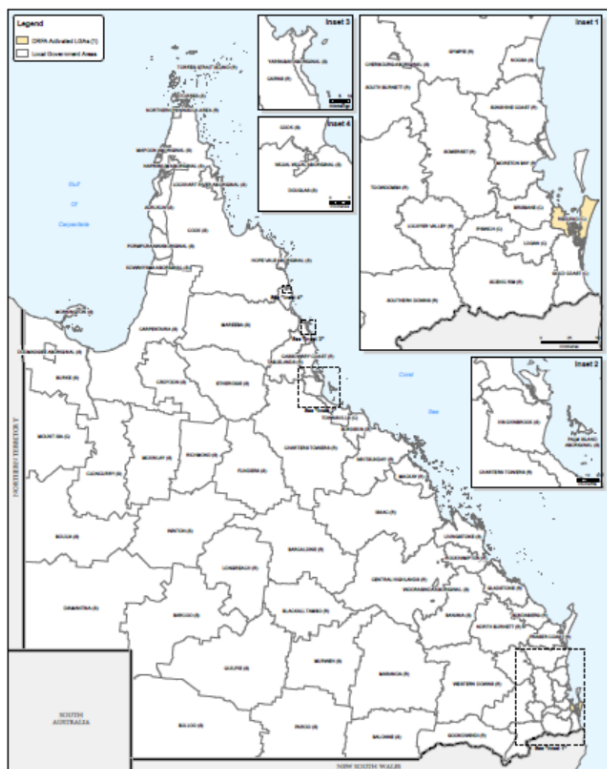




## Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements event Redland Bushfires, 28 November – 13 December 2018



The Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) is a jointly funded program between the Australian Government and state and territory (state) governments, through which the Australian Government provides financial assistance to support state governments with disaster recovery costs.

In response to the bushfires, assistance has been activated for the area formally defined as: “Communities located on islands in the Redland area affected by bushfires, 28 November – 13 December 2018”.

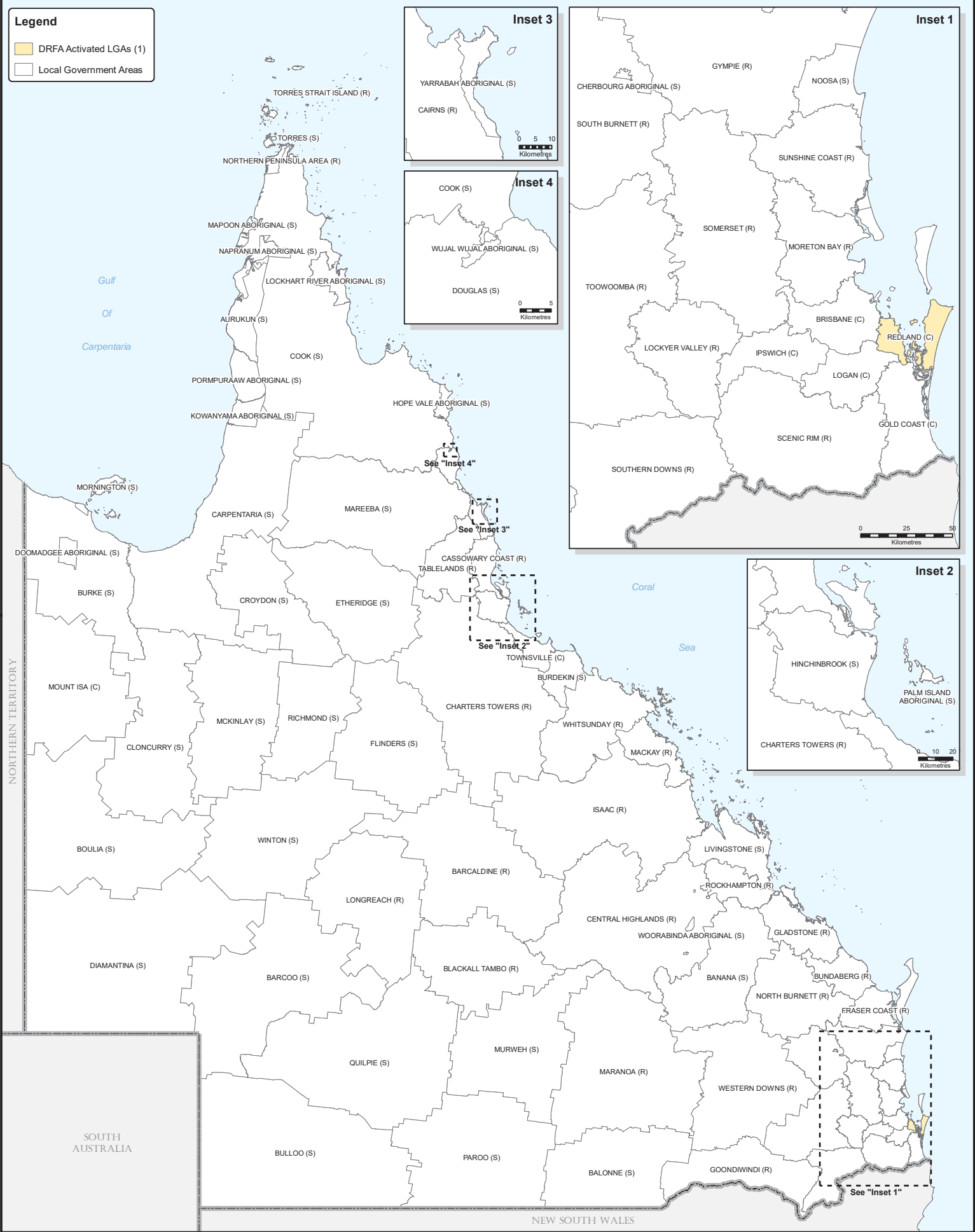

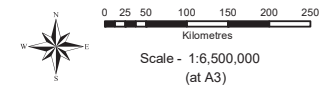
